Dear Mr Green,

I understand that you intend to bring on a Motion of No Confidence in the Speaker as the first order of business when Parliament returns after a three month break on 8<sup>th</sup> March.

On behalf of the Tasmanian Greens MPs, I write to formally request that Parliament be enabled to prioritise detailed questioning of government over its response to the energy crisis, gridlock on the streets of Hobart, the bushfires in the Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area, the devastating outbreak of POMS affecting our oyster growers and the planned sacking of CSIRO climate scientists in Hobart.

While we appreciate it is important to have a question of confidence in the Speaker resolved, the Greens believe the matters confronting the State over this Summer are unprecedented and require the full attention of Parliament on its return after such an extensive break.

We believe this is a time when Tasmanians will be expecting Opposition parties to ask the questions of government that they want answered.
